\*By the Navajo Nation Council Resolution Legislation, No: 0060-20 Temporarily Authorizing Reduced Chapter Meeting Quorum Requirements during the COVID-19 Emergency: Only 3 Elected Officials in the meeting and 5 people maximum to present resolutions pertaining to COVID 19 only:

Navajo Nation Council Resolution CJN-36-21 which, amongst other things, repealed CMA-09-20 and CAP-19-20. When a legislation is repealed, it means that the prior legislation is no longer in effect. However, CJN-36-21 also gives Chapters ninety (90) days to return to their normal quorum and as a result, Cameron Chapter will continue with the 3-Chapter official quorum up to October 4, 2021 to replan the return to 25-member quorum.
